Participants will also gain a more in-depth understanding on the current research focus of the related fields in Hong Kong.

### Paper Submission

Contributed papers should be typed on A4-size paper with 25 mm margin on all sides and limited to 3 pages. The first page should include the paper title, the name and affiliation of all authors, and the e-mail address of the corresponding author. ### HKOEA Best Paper Awards

Three Best papers will be selected for the HKOEA Best Paper Awards. The Best Paper will be awarded a cash prize of HKD 1,000. Two runner up's will each be awarded a cash prize of HKD 500. The Awards will be presented at the closing of the Conference. To be eligible for consideration, the student should be the first author and presenter of the paper.
